COUNCIL NEWS

• Council is developing a draft Municipal Car Parking Provision policy. It will apply in those situations where the calculated additional parking spaces required of a proposed development are unable to be provided due to practical constraints.

The policy, once introduced, is intended to entice developers and businesses to establish commercial activities within the municipality and pay a 'cash in lieu' contribution to the Council; which in turn may allow off site parking for that development.

Currently under Part 10 of the Circular Head S.46 Planning Scheme 1995, developments that cannot provide the required car parking spaces within the property boundaries are recommended for refusal.

It is intended that this policy will aid the commercial expansion of the municipality and will create further employment by permitting developers and businesses to utilise community parking areas.

The Policy will be advertised in the coming months for Public Comment once further developed and endorsed by the Council.

Grade and Roll: Boyndey Road and Greenhills Road.

Grade and Roll, minor re-sheet: Port Road, Malugas Road, Cantara Road, Boys Road.

Shoulder Grade and re-sheet: South Road

Herbicide Spraying: Various Smithton and Stanley Streets.

MAJOR WORKS IN PROGRESS

Nelson Street: Constructing new road and access off Nelson Street. Works to be completed:

- Earthworks for road formation
- Construct new road pavement
- Construct kerb and channel
- Install drainage system
- Lay new asphalt surface
- Provide new line marking
- Install signage

Classic Foods Junction: Project commences April 14. Widening of the Classic Foods access, provision of a slip lane on Trowutta Road and re-surfacing with asphalt. Works to be completed:

- Constructing new pavement for slip lane and access widening
- Construct drainage pipe work
- Construct channel and kerbing on east side of Trowutta Road
- Laying new asphalt
- Line marking

NEW WORKS PROGRAMMED FOR MONTH OF MAY

Dovecote Road and Main Road Junction, Stanley: Widening and realignment of junction. Works to be completed:

- Constructing new pavement
- Placement of traffic islands
- Line marking
- Installing new signage

Main Road Stanley: From Dovecote Road towards Albert Street. Piping of existing open drain and constructing kerb and channel. Works to be completed:

- Laying new drainage pipes
- Construct new road pavement for widening

- Construct kerb and channel
- Sealing between existing and new kerb alignment

This program should be viewed as an indication only as all works are weather dependent.
