KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

AT ITS JUNE MEETING, COUNCIL:

- Noted the activity report of the Weeds Strategy Officer for the months of March to May 2010. The report notes the establishment of the Circular Head Landcare Group (CHLG). CHLG is currently made up of volunteers. Its objectives include the reversal of land, water and vegetation degradation through strategic on-ground actions and to increase awareness about ecologically sustainable land and water use and specific "landcare" practices.
- Adopted the Annual Plan and Budget Estimates for 2010/11 along with the Rates Resolution for 2010/11.
- Elected Councillor Oldaker and Mayor Quilliam to the Circular Head Recreation Advisory Committee, with Mayor Quilliam also elected as the Chairperson of the Committee. The Committee is a strategic special committee which will provide a mechanism for Council to improve the strategic planning and coordination of recreation throughout the municipality. - Reconfirmed the role of the Stanley Caravan Park Advisory Committee and confirmed four memberships of the Committee.
- Noted the Financial Reports for the period ended 31 May 2010.
- Noted the Minutes of the Central Outdoor Area Management Committee, Northern Area Management Committee, Western Area Management Committee, Stanley Town Hall Special Committee and the Circular Head Education & Training Consultative Committee.
