## KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

### AT ITS MARCH MEETING, COUNCIL:

- Endorsed the draft Community Small Grants Scheme Policy for public comment. This policy combines the former Community Grants Policy and Club Development Fund Policy into one. Under the Community Small Grants Scheme Policy there are four categories - minor works; culture and events; sport and recreation; health and wellbeing.
- Endorsed the Revised Public Open Space Contributions Policy
- Adopted the Pricing and Sales Policy for the Circular Head Profile (second edition 2008)

## WORKS PLUS APRIL WORKS

### GENERAL WORKS

Grade and Roll: Minor Resheet: Bolduans Road, Davey Point Road and Old Port Road.

Shouldering: Montumanna Road

Edge Break Repairs: Mengha Road

Installing new signage and guideposts: Backline Road

Heavy Patching: Grooms Cross Road

Driveway Crossing Repairs: Emmett and Nelson Streets

Repairing Concrete Footpaths: Emmett and Nelson Streets

### CAPITAL WORKS IN PROGRESS

Marthicks Road – widen junction and improve drainage. Works scheduled for completion by end of March.

Montagu Road – from Old Port Road to Jacksons Road. Realign, widen and seal. Works programmed for next 4 weeks

- Widen existing pavement
- Reconstruction sections of existing road
- Install culverts
- Install sub-soil drainage
- Construct kerb and channel

Traffic delays of up to 10 minutes may occur during these works.

Dovecote Road/Main Road Junction Stanley – Alter intersection and pipe sections of open drain. These works are designed to improve safety for vehicles negotiating the intersection. Works programmed for completion by April 24.

Smith Street Upgrade – Intersection and road surface improvements extending from roundabout to eastern end of Smith Street. Works programmed for next 4 weeks:

- Install stormwater pits
- Construct new kerb and channel
- Pave footpaths
- Construct new roundabout

West Esplanade – increase car parking area and seal, seal access road, install lighting and erect new fencing. Works programmed for completion by end of April.

## CAPITAL WORKS IN PLANNING STAGE

- Hotmix existing and construct new walking tracks in Smithton – from boat ramp to Cantara Road
- Boyndey Road/Bass Highway Junction – realign and seal junction
