<p><u>AT ITS SEPTEMBER MEETING, COUNCIL:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adopted measures to enhance pedestrian safety on footpaths within the central business district by declaring cycling and skating No Go Zones on footpaths within: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Emmett Street, between King and Smith Street ⇒ King Street, between Emmett & Nelson Street ⇒ Smith Street, between Emmett and Nelson Street ⇒ Nelson Street, between King and Smith Street • Amended the fees and charges for the Circular Head War Memorial Swimming Pool by including a Pensioner Family Half Year season ticket at \$100 and a Pensioner Family Full Year season ticket at \$175. • Rescheduled its October meeting to 25 October due to the Local Government Manager's Association State Conference at Tall Timbers • Rescheduled its December meeting from 20 December to 13 December so that decisions made at the meeting could be processed before the Christmas/New Year holidays. • Amended the Council Christmas closure to begin at 12 noon on Friday 21 December 2007.
