KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

AT ITS FEBRUARY MEETING, COUNCIL:

- Noted and received the transfer of Titles of the Crown Land Transfers for land to Circular Head Council under the Crown Land Assessment and Classification Project.
- Endorsed the final draft (Version 6) Shareholders' Letter of Expectation for the Tasmanian Water and Sewerage Corporation North-Western Region Pty Ltd, including minor amendments.
