KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

AT ITS MARCH MEETING, COUNCIL:

- Executed a Memorandum of Understanding between Council and the Circular Head Tourism Association (CHTA) for the period July 2007 to June 2010. The CHTA must prepare and submit an Annual Report to Council by 30 September each year.

WORKS PLUS APRIL WORKS

GENERAL WORKS

Grade and Roll—Minor Resheet: Anthony Beach Road, Purdy's Road, Alcomie Cross Road, Huetts Road, Maguires Road, Old Line Road, Fords Road, Inness Road and Fagans Road.

CAPITAL WORKS IN PROGRESS

West Esplanade/Montagu Road Junction

Works programmed for the next 4 weeks:

- laying new asphalt surface (scheduled for mid-March)
- installing line-marking and road markers
- concreting footpaths

West Esplanade Reconstruction

Works programmed for the next 4 weeks:

- constructing channel and kerbing
- installing storm water pits
- reconstructing pavement

West Esplanade Toilet Facility

- Installing new toilet module – programmed to be installed by end of March

Trowutta and Roger River Roads

- Replacing bridges – minor disruptions to traffic flows are anticipated during construction

Newhaven Track

- Clearing corners at various locations to improve sight paths

This program should be viewed as an indication only as all works are weather dependent.
