## KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

### AT ITS JUNE MEETING, COUNCIL:

- Adopted the estimates of revenue and expenditure (including fees and charges) for the 2009/10 financial year as detailed in the Annual Plan and Budget Estimates in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government Act 1993.
- Adopted the Rates Resolution for the period 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2010. Council will offer a discount of 4.0% on the total rates and charges for the period 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2010, specified in a rates notice, for payment of the total rates and charges (including all arrears) that are paid by 31 August 2009.
- Approved an application from Optus Mobile Pty Ltd to install a new telecommunications facility on rural land along Wells Road, Stanley, approximately 1.7km south-west of the town centre. It was determined that there are broad community benefits associated with improved telecommunications infrastructure in Circular Head, including choice and competition. The proposal as approved had been amended from the original in order to minimise visual intrusion in the landscape.

### CAPITAL WORKS IN PROGRESS

- Final reinstatement of site
- Line marking approaches to roundabout

Smithton Walking Tracks: Construction works have commenced linking the existing walk track adjacent to the boat ramp in East Esplanade with King Street. Works include the locating of a toilet module similar to that in West Esplanade.
