KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

AT ITS MAY MEETING, COUNCIL:

- Adopted a strategy to consider the spread of declared weeds during the approval process for development applications that involve major earth disturbance, road works, or the import/export of soil or quarried materials.

GENERAL WORKS

Grade and Roll – Minor Resheet: Poilinna Road, Red Marsh Road, Sealer Springs Road, Woolnorth Road, Boydne Road, Marthicks Road, Temma Track.

Maintenance to Hotmix Surface: Apex Walkway – between East Esplanade and Kay Streets.

Various Stanley areas: Re-surfacing footpaths with asphalt.

CAPITAL WORKS IN PROGRESS

West Esplanade Reconstruction
Works programmed for next 2 weeks:

- Sealing pavement
- Reinstating driveways and naturestrips

- Installing signage
- Linemarking

West Esplanade Toilet Facility
• Commissioning new toilet module

Hellyer Street
Works programmed for next 4 weeks:

- Removing existing kerb and channel
- Preparing base for new kerbing
- Constructing new kerbing
- Carrying out minor roadworks

Roger River Road
• Replacing bridge – bypass provided during construction.

Tatlows Beach Walkway
• Between Caravan Park and Hursey Seafoods – constructing footings in preparation for new light poles.

This program should be viewed as an indication only as all works are weather dependent.
