<p><u>AT ITS NOVEMBER MEETING, COUNCIL:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resolved to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Initiate an amendment to the Circular Head s.46 Planning Scheme to facilitate reuse and redevelopment of the Stanley Port; ⇒ Direct staff to work with TasPorts and their representatives to develop appropriate amendments to be submitted to the Council as Planning Authority at a later date; ⇒ Delegate power provided under Section 33(2) of the Act to determine when the form of the amendment is approved to then allow for further processing to the Senior Planner. • Adopted the Recreation Plan which includes the employment of a dedicated Recreation Officer. • Agreed to commit additional expenditure of \$150,000 for the construction of four tennis/netball courts at the CRC and upgrades to the associated facility. • Adopted the Youth Policy and Strategies and will consider funding commitment during budget deliberations so as to identify, prioritise and implement strategies from the Youth Policy. • Adopted to support the National Seachange Taskforce by becoming a member of the formally constituted organisation.
