KEY COUNCIL MEETING DECISIONS

AT ITS SEPTEMBER MEETING.

COUNCIL:

- Endorsed the Roadside Crash Marker Program Community Road Safety Initiative within the Circular Head Municipality.
- Authorised the Manager of Infrastructure and Development Services to respond to the Department of Primary Industries and Water's Cat Management Position Paper as detailed in the report to Council of 18 September 2008.

WORKS PLUS SEPTEMBER WORKS

GENERAL WORKS

Grade and Roll – Minor Resheet: Partridge Road, Eldridge Road, Fagans Road, Lades Road and Lovetts Road.

Culvert Maintenance: Various rural roads.

Bridge Deck Replacement: Kubanks Road, Dallas Road, Cyathea Road and Dip Falls Road.

Footpath Inspections and Maintenance: Smithton and Stanley Streets.

CAPITAL WORKS PROPOSED TO COMMENCE EARLY OCTOBER

King Street – between Hill Street and Sampsons Ave.
Scope of works:

- installation of stormwater drainage
- construction of new kerbing
- lower road east of Massey Street
- lay new asphalt surface

The construction period is estimated to be 10 weeks and the public are asked to abide by all signage and, if possible, avoid using King Street while construction works are being carried out.

Trowutta Road – realign corner adjacent to Copper Downs. Scope of works:

- remove vegetation
- construct new road to improve curve alignment
- install crash barriers and signage

Extensive clearing and re-fencing of boundaries will take place early October but road construction will not begin until January 2009.

This program should be viewed as an indication only as all works are weather dependent.
