"Council is currently developing a 10 year 'Settlement Strategy', which is intended to create a clear vision for the future development of our community and will focus on things our community deem important to them, including population, lifestyle, recreation, tourism, housing, business and industry." Said Circular Head Mayor, Daryl Quilliam.

The plan will have clear objectives to maximise opportunities, address challenges and be fully supported by goals resulting from extensive research and consultation with the community.

Council will be consulting with the community with a Draft Settlement Strategy in 2021 but to start with we are looking for early input from you now. We would like your thoughts about living in Circular Head, important issues to you, and your opinions on growth.
