Circular Head Council endorse dual naming

Circular Head Mayor Daryl Quilliam and Councillors support the submission to dual name local landmarks in the North West.

Council was approached by the Circular Head Aboriginal Corporation (CHAC) to endorse their request of renaming seven landmarks within the North West of Tasmania. The submission for dual naming is due on the 31st of March to the Nomenclature Board.

"Councillors and I are pleased to support the submission from CHAC for dual naming of seven sites in our community" Mayor Quilliam said. "It is important that the locally used languages are applied to any dual naming, and by working with CHAC and local historians Council support these names"

The seven landmarks there were submitted and endorsed for dual naming are:

Cape Grim - Kennaook

Doughboys - Koindrim being the collective name for the two islands

Inner island (Doughboys) Kaninerwidic

Outer Island (Doughboys) Karrernootong

Trefoil - Tademer

Woolnorth point - Temdudheker
