

## ROTARY CLUB OF SMITHTON SCHOLARSHIP

## **SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- 1. The successful candidate must demonstrate that without support from the fund, he / she would experience hardship or find it difficult to access further education.
- 2. The successful candidate should be able to demonstrate that he / she has explored other avenues of assistance.
- 3. The Scholarship will be awarded to a candidate choosing to study in Tasmania.
- 4. The successful candidate will demonstrate their interest and involvement in the Circular Head community.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The successful applicant must have successfully completed Grade 12 or be a mature age student. The Scholarship is open to anyone except Rotary members and their families. Please contact the Rotary Club for eligibility requirements if a family member has been a past Rotarian.

In the event that the successful candidate receives additional support (eg Scholarship or Bursary), he / she is obliged to inform the Rotary Club of Smithton Selection Committee, which will review the situation and make recommendations.

The Rotary Club of Smithton Scholarship is \$2500 and the Selection Committee reserves the right to allocate the funds to more than one recipient if deemed worthy.

Funding will only be made available in circumstances where a suitable candidate is identified.

The funding allocation will be made in two equal part payments:-

- The first allocation will be made in the first semester upon receipt of proof of enrolment and
- The second allocation will be made at the beginning of the second semester upon proof of continued enrolment.

Applicants will be shortlisted and an interview conducted.

The successful candidate will be invited to share their experience of their education journey at a Rotary Club of Smithton dinner meeting.
