



## **CIRCULAR HEAD MAYOR DARYL QUILLIAM'S MESSAGE 13 FEBRUARY 2018**

Last weekend the Deputy Mayor Jan Bishop and I attended the opening of the new gymnastics premises in Smithton. The small committee has done a great job in getting this facility ready for our young children to be able to start training and learning new skills. They were fortunate to be able to find a fully qualified trainer to help out as well. The large number of children, parents and grandparents who attended this event shows this sport is needed in our community and it is great to see that it is up and running again. Liberal member for Braddon Roger Jaensch has announced a grant of \$50,000 would be available to upgrade the building should the Government be re-elected next month. I hope to see Labor also announce a funding commitment for this club.

Road infrastructure rehabilitation and upgrade works located on the section of Montagu Road Smithton between the Duck River and Lane Park, are progressing well. Current works are focussed on the construction of road pavement, concrete kerb, footpath and driveways. It is expected that access to some properties along this section of Montagu Road may be unavailable for short periods of time during driveway/ kerb construction. Council's Works Department will however endeavour to keep inconvenience to a minimum. Sections of the road are currently under traffic light control, which may cause a light disruption to traffic flow.
