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ENTRY TO PORT LATTA LANDFILL APPLICATION

PORT LATTA LANDFILL - ACCESS APPROVALS

In accordance with "Operate Schedule Premises" Licence Number 3886 issued by the Division of Environment only an approved contractor may enter the Port Latta Landfill to dispose of refuse.

DEFINITIONS

An approved contractor is a person or organisation:

- 1. That collects refuse for a financial return,
- 2. That disposes a minimum 1 tonne of refuse in any one trip and 100 tonne per year,
- 3. That only uses an approved vehicle to enter the site,
- 4. That holds a current written approval from Council and complies with any conditions in that approval.

Approved Vehicles allowed entry to the site must:

- 1. Be a commercial registered vehicle,
- 2. Be such that at no time during transportation of putrescible waste will the waste, once placed in Collection Vehicle, be in any way exposed to the weather, exposed to view or accessible to vermin and pests, and
- 3. Be such that at no time during transportation of the refuse will odours, refuse, sludge, dust or other matter, escape from the vehicle.

Occasional Access

- 1. Occasional access may be obtained by persons with an appropriate vehicle at the discretion of the General Manager or Director of Infrastructure and Development Services where, due to physical constraints disposal at the White Hills Transfer Station is not practical.
- 2. Approval is granted on the condition that the contractor disposes of approved refuse as directed by the Site Operator and in accordance with the license conditions.

Termination of Approval

Council may terminate an approval of a contractor by 30 days prior written notice if:

- 1. The contractor has breached any of the above requirements
- 2. Council officers determine the waste may be detrimental to site operations
- 3. The contractor is in arrears of payment of any fees with respect to the Port Latta Landfill and that breach still exists at the end of the notice

Waste

Adequate details of the type of waste and its source shall be provided to determine the classification of materials in accordance with the relevant guidelines (e.g. Classification and Management of Contaminated Soil for Disposal)

Permits

The Permit as issued shall be presentable to the Site Operator to verify entry to the site. Should the permit not be presented, entry will be refused.
