Visitor Information services are now available in Smithton.

A visitor information centre is now housed in Circular Head's newest attraction, the Duck River Pavilions. It shares the building with the Circular Head Heritage Centre, a theatrette and a brand-new café facility.

The Heritage Centre was formerly housed in King Street, Smithton and showcases interesting and informative displays depicting the unique history of the region. An operator for the café is being sought.

Smithton's Visitor Information Centre is staffed by experienced and friendly locals with extensive local and regional knowledge. They are happy to assist with travel advice on all aspects of tourism in Circular Head and other parts of Tasmania, and can make bookings for guides, tours, accommodation, festivals and events.

Maps and brochures are available. Souvenirs, gifts, and books are also available for purchase.

There will also be a visitor information service at Stanley Cabin and Tourist Park for the winter season, while a long-term location for visitor services in Stanley is determined.
